- Quick-Trak self-serve ticketing kiosk available for credit/debit card sales.
- Thruway Bus Connections, providing coordinated train/bus service with connections at the Amtrak station (in most cases), as well as through fares/ticketing. Passengers traveling on Thruway connecting buses must be ticketed before boarding buses in order to obtain through fares. Greyhound, Northwestern Stages, Olympic Bus Lines, Porter Stage Lines, The Shuttle and Western Trailways of Canada are normally not accessible to passengers in wheelchairs. However, these carriers will provide an accessible vehicle when given 24-48 hours notice. Please consult Amtrak for details.
- Checked Baggage Service available at stations indicated.
- Ticket office open for all train departures.
- Ticket office/checked baggage not open for all departures.
- Tickets can not be purchased at this location.
- All station facilities are fully accessible to persons using wheelchairs. Barrier-free access between street or parking lot, station platform and trains; however, not all facilities within the station are fully accessible.

- Friday/Sunday Express bus departs University of Oregon 3:10 p.m.; Eugene 3:35 p.m. and arrives Portland 5:25 p.m.
- At the time Train 516 begins service to Vancouver, BC, the Thruway bus will operate one hour earlier as a connection from Train 506 at 5:30 p.m.
- *** Reserved Friday and Sunday. Buses 5588 and 5577 are sponsored by the Oregon Department of Transportation. They will run as a test through the summer 2009. Normal service will resume Friday, September 4, 2009. Will not operate 9/6/09; will also operate 9/7/09.

CROSSING THE U.S./CANADIAN BORDER Customs and Immigration Information

Persons crossing the border by land or sea, including on Amtrak trains and Thruway services, must have one secure Western Hemisphere Travel Initiative-compliant document that proves both citizenship and identity. For American citizens 16 and over, this document must be one of the following: passport, passport card, trusted traveler card (NEXUS, SENTRI, or FAST), enhanced driver's license, merchant mariner document, military ID with military orders, or form I-872 (American Indian card). For Canadian citizens, one of the following is required: passport, trusted traveler card or an enhanced driver's license. For citizens of other countries, a passport, and in many cases a visa, is required. A passenger 15 and younger who does not have one of the above documents may present a certified copy of his or her birth certificate only. Passengers under 18 not traveling with both parents require a notarized letter from any parent not present giving permission to cross the border. Admission into either country is solely at the discretion of border authorities, and possession of required documentation in no way guarantees entry. When you make your cross-border reservation with either Amtrak or VIA Rail Canada, your date of birth, country of citizenship, and identification information will be required; this information is provided to border authorities. For further information and to determine what is required for your particular situation, contact the appropriate U.S. or Canadian government agencies prior to travel.

Passengers holding multi-ride tickets should be aware that reserved and ticketed passengers have priority seating on Amtrak Thruway buses.
